What: If you are looking for home accessories with a strong Asian aesthetic, Kai Life is a good place to start. Launched this July, the affordable gems that are housed in this 300 sq ft boutique lifestyle shop are rich in floral and brocade detailing such as the cotton and suede cushions embroidered with dragonfly and butterfly motifs. You'll also be able to find other furnishings like pebble-shaped lamps or gifts for friends like the handmade sterling silver jewellery and semi-precious stones. Father and daughter team Wong Mun Kai, 63, and Shareen Wong, 33, runs the show. Shareen, who co-hosts *The Morning Jam* on Power98FM, sources for the furnishings in Indonesia, Thailand and Vietnam while Mun Kai is an artist whose paintings of floral still life and Balinese sunsets are sold at the shop. Art commissions are available as well.
